FOSTER PROGRAM TERMS AND DISCLOSURE

FOSTER PROGRAM TERMS:

Home Of Our Own Foundation (HOOOF) determines the criteria for fostering as well as deciding which animals are eligible for foster care. HOOOF will require you to complete a HOOOF Foster Parent Agreement Form prior to being accepted as a foster parent. HOOOF staff/veterinary will inform you of any medical treatments to be administered, the anticipated length of the foster care period, the objectives of each particular placement (restoring to health, rearing to adoptable age, socialization, etc.), any medical treatments to be administered, and any other restrictions or expectations we may have. You will be expected to keep the animal safe and secure, and return it to HOOOF when requested to do so, and not promise the animal to anyone, or imply that you have the authority to approve a potential adoption. HOOOF retains ownership of all animals placed in foster care, and will make all decisions regarding the adoption & placement of the animals fostered.

DISCLOSURE:

I have read and understand the statements above. I certify that all the information contained in this application is true and correct. I understand that although HOOOF takes reasonable care to screen animals for foster care placement, it makes no guarantees relating to the animals' health, behavior or actions. I understand that I receive foster care animals at my own risk and can decline to accept any animal for which HOOOF has asked me to provide care. I acknowledge that HOOOF is not responsible for any property damage or personal injury suffered by me, members of my household, including my own animals, or any third parties during a foster placement, and I assume liability to provide adequate controls to prevent such damage or injury.
